



**THE ANNUAL REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES OF MARY WARD SCHOOL,  
LUBHOO, LALITPUR**

**FOR THE YEAR 2013 AD**

**(01-06-2014)**

The School re-opened for the new session on 21<sup>st</sup> April 2013. We have UKG to Class 10 with 310 students on the roll. There are 16 teachers and 4 sisters in the school.

Mary Ward School was established in 2097 AD. (2054 BS) The purpose of this school is to cater for the girls of the underprivileged of the society in Lubhoo and the near by villages. It is an extended social service of St. Mary's School, Jawalakhel, Lalitpur. This school is meant for the poorest of the poor. There are generous people who help us to run the school, like St. Mary's Alumnae (ASMAN) and a few local people. This Institution admits girls of all communities irrespective of caste, creed and religion. The School imparts not only academic education to the students but also helps them to form an integrated personality by developing in them a strong character, love of truth, respect, loyalty, a sense of justice and honesty and hard work. Our school aims at creating confident women who can face the challenges of life.

It is a regular feature of our school to offer opportunities to our students to develop their talents through various extra-curricular and co-curricular activities. We have Value Education classes and organized Assemblies, One Act plays, singing, dancing, elocution, recitation, Debates-- both Nepali and English for all the classes. We also have physical education, games period and annual sports/parents day celebration. The students are taught Needle work, craft, handwork, singing, story telling and handwriting. Our students learn computer from class 1 to class 10. This year our school is upgraded into English Medium up to class 5. Now the whole primary section is English Medium.

During the course of the year we had educational trips and exposure programmes. We organized awareness programmes such as girl-trafficking, carrier counseling, environmental awareness, women empowerment, health camps and earth quake disaster prevention drills for the students and the staff. In the school we have environment club, Literary club & Bal club which are very active. We have Environment club garden where students work in this garden during their period once a week which is part of their Environment project. This year our Annual Parents Day' was on 14<sup>th</sup> Dec 2013, students under the guidance of the Sisters & Teachers displayed their talents, which was well appreciated by the parents and guests.

We have Unit tests and three Terms Exams in a year and the promotion to the next class is granted partly on the daily assessment and on the Terminal Examinations. Free evening coaching classes are conducted for the weak and poor local students of our school. We are proud of our SLC students result for their wonderful performance. On 8<sup>th</sup> March, International Women's day. We had talent contest for our students of our high school, which encouraged them to express their talents in form of a dancing, singing, mono act, mimicry, miming and speeches on women empowerment topic, Which build their self confidence and help them to become broad minded. The best performers were awarded.

Free Mid-day meal is provided daily to the poor students of our primary section and High school. We visit students' families to come to know them and their background.

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
